

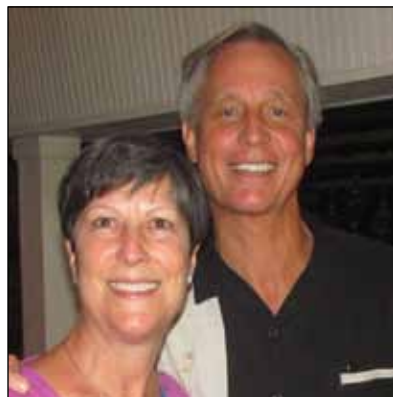
# COMMUNITY LIFE
